The Quality Technician is responsible for performing a variety of functions to support the overall quality system. This position also supports Quality and/or cross-functional improvement initiatives, CAPA projects and internal audits.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Inspect incoming materials against material specification requirements
- Inspect set up, in-process and final products to ensure they meet customer specifications

- Perform daily quality inspections of all work-in process
- Assemble and review of device history records
- Act as liaison between production personnel and Quality in regard to quality issues
- Maintain quality control department files
- Use and read measuring equipment as required. Includes micrometers, rulers, calipers, gauges and testers
- Maintain and perform calibrations and/or devices maintenance
- Review monthly schedule to ensure equipment is calibrated and maintained per schedule
- Conduct training as required
- Assist in the root cause investigation of non-conforming product
- Assist with document control and archiving activities
